When a family has a sick person in hospital they try their best to give any assistance required by health personnel so as to save life of the sick. In case of an operation, the patient must be given blood. Some of the cases that require blood transfusion are emergencies and may not wait for family members to come and donate blood. For this reason, hospitals usually have blood stored in special bags under suitable conditions to ensure safety. A person who donate blood is called a 'recipient.' Once a certain amount of blood is withdrawn from the blood bank it must be replaced. You are encouraged regularly to donate blood even though blood transfusion has no effects. A person can donate a pint of blood once every three months one time you donate a pint of blood, the body replaces the same in about three months.

Due to unwillingness of people to donate blood, hospitals place conditions to the family of the sick that at least somebody should donate blood to save their kin if he/she must receive blood. In this case if the hospital has compatible blood, they use it for transfusion and family member to replace the donated blood. Once the blood is free from diseases like HIV/AIDS, hepatitis and even malaria.
